NOTES FOR GUIDANCE

The u3a is a self-help, self-managed, lifelong learning cooperative. Members share knowledge, skills and experiences and contribute to the organisation by different means. Some people help in practical ways, such as helping with administration or refreshments, and others enjoy sharing their knowledge, skills and expertise by giving talks or leading a group.

U3as differ from other educational organisations and courses. Members do not study for examinations or certificates, there are no entrance qualifications – a desire to learn is all that is required. u3a groups often meet in Members' homes or local halls. (Groups meeting in halls charge an extra 35p per hour towards hall hire).

Our website and Group Information Bulletin (GIB) give information about the very wide variety of groups we offer. These include academic subjects, arts and crafts and leisure activities. The reference to 'Third Age' relates to the fact that u3a is aimed at older people, no longer in full time employment or with parental responsibilities. Our groups mainly meet in the daytime. Before applying for membership, you may wish to contact the Conveners of any groups you would like to join, to ensure their activities reflect your interest and that the groups can accommodate you.

As a self-help organisation we rely on our members to help in a variety of ways from refreshments, general organisation, administration, publicity to joining the Committee or providing expertise in subject matters or IT.
